ABSTRACT

Presenters of papers or posters should send an abstract of not more than 300 words in English, typed in Times New Roman, Font 12, spacing 1.5, margins 1 inch all sides and be received by 12th April 2019 through the email: conference19@kibu.ac.ke. The abstract should include background, objectives, methodology, results and conclusion. It should also include the title, author's name, affiliation institution, email address, phone number and subtheme.

FULL PAPERS

The full papers for accepted abstracts should be submitted by 3rd May 2019. The full papers should be 3000 to 5000 words, prepared in Times New Romans Font 12, spacing 1.5.
Empirical papers: Cover page with Title of Paper, Abstract (300 words), Key words (maximum 5), Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and

Discussion, Conclusion and Recommendations, References

Posters: Height 80cm Width 60cm or A1 paper.

References: Use APA style 6th edition; avoid footnotes.

Avoid references in abstract

Appendices: Should follow references
